learned APP for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in

a case registered for the offences punishable under

Sections 341, 323, 313, 354, 379, 504/34 of the Indian

Penal Code and section $\frac{3}{4}$ of the Witch Practices Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks

permission to withdraw the petition with regard to

petitioner No. 1 namely, Sunil Sahani.



Permission is accorded.

Accordingly, the petition with regard to petitioner No. 1 is permitted to be dismissed as withdrawn.

It is a case of assaulting due to which the informant sustained injuries and her pregnancy got terminated.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. The allegation against the petitioners, except petitioner No. 1 is general and omnibus. The informant and her husband sustained simple injuries caused by hard and blunts substance. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

In the facts and circumstance of the case, let the petitioners, above named, except petitioner No. 1, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, be



released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousands) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Harsidhi P.S. Case No. 308 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
