4 22-12-2022 Petitioners have prayed for the following relief(s):-

“(A) For issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the possession notice dated 02.02.2019 (Annexure-2) issued by the Central Bank of India, Regional Office, Patna whereby and whereunder the respondent bank has taken possession of the property described in the aforesaid notice in exercise of



powers conferred on him/her under Sub-Section (4) of Section 13 of the Act read with the rule 8 of the Security Interest (Enforcement) Rules 2002.

(B) For directing the respondent bank to not disturb the possession of the petitioners regarding property in question during the pendency of the instant writ application.

(C) For any other reliefs to which the petitioners are found entitled to in the facts and circumstances of this case.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners, under instructions, states that, in view of the intervening developments, the petition may be permitted to be withdrawn.

Prayer allowed.

Petition is disposed of as withdrawn.
