7 10-08-2022 The limited prayer of the petitioners in the present writ petition is to direct the Circle Officer, Azamnagar, Katihar i.e. the Respondent No. 6 to dispose of the Encroachment Cases No. 21 of 2019-20 and 22 of 2019-20 by passing final order u/s



6(1) of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956.
