2 28-09-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 354B, 379, 385, 427, 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly, it is a case of assault and outraging the modesty of the informant.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. He



further submits that there is land dispute between the parties and the snatched stolen money was not recovered from the possession of the petitioners.

Learned APP appearing for the State opposed the anticipatory bail.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM-I, Benipatti, Madhubani in connection with Complaint Case No. 362 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
