ORAL ORDER

3 23-12-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties through video conferencing.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in a case registered under sections 304B, 201 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the prosecution case, the accused persons including the petitioner herein who happens to be the husband of the deceased tortured the daughter of the informant for non-fulfillment of the demand of dowry.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case only for the reason that he happens to be the husband of the deceased. The allegations are false and concocted. Chargesheet has been submitted in the case. The petitioner is in custody



since 29.6.2021. He undertakes to cooperate in the trial.

Heard learned counsel for the APP.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner being the husband of the deceased, chargesheet having been submitted under section 304B of the Indian Penal Code besides other sections and the cause of death in the postmortem report having been given as asphyxia due to strangulation (throttling), and postmortem drowning, the Court is not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail and the application is rejected.

Learned trial court is directed to expedite the trial.
