ORAL ORDER

3 10-01-2022 Heard the parties through video conferencing.

It appears that vide order dated 06.12.2021, the application with regard to petitioner no. 2, namely Babloo Paswan has already permitted to be withdrawn and this application is now restricted to petitioner no. 1, namely Uttam Kumar Paswan.

The petitioner no. 1 seeks bail in anticipation of his arrest in connection with Kawakole P.S. Case No. 266 of 2020 instituted for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 325, 308, 354(A), 379, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner no.1 submits that there are compromise arrived at between the parties and there

are cross cases relating to the same incident, I am inclined to allow the petitioner no.1, namely Uttam Kumar Paswan on bail, in the event of arrest he shall be released on anticipatory bail, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
