2 21-07-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

Let the defect(s), if any, as pointed out by the office
be removed within four weeks.

As reflects from the FIR that the case has been
registered under Sections 302/120(B)/34 of the Indian Penal
Code and there is specific allegation amongst other the
petitioner herein that he gave one of the fatal blow to the
informant's husband.

Taking into account the fact that there is direct
allegation of assault by the petitioner herein on the informant's
husband (deceased) as also the fact that the FIR was registered
attributing specific allegation against the petitioner in March,



2019 whereas the petitioner chose to come into judicial custody only in December, 2021 i.e. after two years and nine months, this Court is not inclined to grant him the privilege of bail which is accordingly, rejected.

The trial Court is hereby directed to expedite the trial and conclude the same to its logical conclusion at an earliest.
