2 24-02-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Barauli P.S. Case No. 396 of 2019 registered under Sections 302/120(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case due to enmity, dirty village politics and some ulterior motives. Further he submits that in the instant case, complaint case is filed after lapse of three months of the alleged occurrence. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.



Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of A.C.J.M.-XVI, Gopalganj in connection with Barauli P.S. Case No. 396 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
