This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Kochas P.S. Case No. 02 of 2018 for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341 & 302 of the Indian Penal Code.

It has been submitted that the petitioners have been summoned to face the trial under Section 319 of the Cr.P.C. by an order dated 02.03.2020, which is a non-reasoned order.

Considering the aforesaid facts, this bail application is allowed.



Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest/surrender within ten weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-V, Rohtas at Sasaram, in connection with Kochas P.S. Case No. 02 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
