2 22-04-2022 The matter is being heard through video conferencing
due to circumstances prevailing on account of Covid-19
pandemic.

Heard the parties.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Paroo P.S. Case No. 299 of 2021 registered for the offence
under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise
(Amendment) Act, 2018.

Recovery of 202.59 litres of illicit liquor has been
made from Magic vehicle. On seeing the police personnel, the
accused persons fled away from the place of occurrence and
they have been identified by the local people and Chowkidar.

In view of the allegations levelled against the
petitioner, this anticipatory bail application is not maintainable



in view of the judgment of the Full Bench of this Court in the case of *Ram Binay Yadav Vs. The State of Bihar* reported in [2019 (2) PLJR 1089 (Full Bench)]. Accordingly, it is dismissed as not maintainable.
