learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with
Kundwa Chainpur P.S. Case No. 62 of 2020 registered under
Sections 30(a) and 41(i) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise
Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have falsely
been implicated in the present case. From perusal of seizure list,
it is apparent that nothing has been recovered from the
possession of these petitioners. Further he submits that
petitioners have no criminal antecedent.



Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of the Special Judge (Excise Act), East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Kundwa Chainpur P.S. Case No. 62 of 2020, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
