*“ (a) For a direction upon the Respondents
to grant Samman pension under J.P. Samman*

(b) For a direction to the Respondents to pay arrears of Samman Pension to the petitioners which has not been paid to the petitioners despite being recommended for the same by Three-Men Committee along with penal interest.”

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioners seek liberty on behalf of the petitioners to approach the Secretary, Advisory Council, J.P. Samman Pension Scheme, Patna for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty so sought, is granted.
