“i) To issue writ/writs, order/orders direction/directions in the nature of CERTIORARI for quashing the Notice Inviting Request For Proposal being NIT No. 27/PR/SBPDCL/2019 and 28/PR/SBPDCL/2019 by which the Tailor made conditions have been inserted with the sole view to deprive the existing contractors from participating in the aforesaid tender and facilitating the persons having big capital to fetch the work order and the same being also irrational and against the larger public interest and consequent upon quashing the same, issuance of direction to the Respondents to allow the Petitioners to continue in terms of on going agreement.

ii) To any other relief or reliefs to which the Petitioner is found entitled to.”
