2 20-12-2022 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following reliefs:-

“1(A). Issuance of an appropriate writ / order / direction commanding respondents to enquire into / cause inquiry of, the works of NALI-GALI under the scheme Mukhya Mantri Nischaya Yojna done in the year 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 pertaining to ward nos.04 and 05 Sarmera Panchayat, afresh by a team of expert



in presence of the petitioners and after considering the case of the petitioners, for giving a specific, clear and unambiguous report with regard to the works, referred to above as well as the role of the petitioners making them subject to penal/coercive action or not;

B. Any other reliefs for which the petitioners are entitled to.”

After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to avail such other alternative remedies as are available under the law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
