2 28-02-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Barhara P.S. Case No. 295 of 2019 registered under Sections 384, 387, 307/34 of the Indian Penal Code and 27 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case due to previous enmity. Further he submits that both the parties have compromised the present case, as contained in Annexure-2 to the bail application.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below



within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of C.J.M., Bhojpur at Ara in connection with Barhara P.S. Case No. 295 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
