2 25-05-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner seeks bail in Hathua P.S. Case No. 294 of 2021 registered for the offence under Sections 302 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

As per the prosecution case, it is alleged that petitioner with the help of his associates killed the brother of the informant.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. From bare perusal of the F.I.R. it is evident that a vague suspicion has been alleged against the petitioner and informant is not an eye witness of the alleged occurrence. Petitioner is in custody since 15.11.2021 and investigation is complete. It further submitted that petitioner is accused in seven cases but he



is on acquittal in all cases.

Learned APP vehemently opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the above named petitioner be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-XIV, Gopalganj in connection with Hathua P.S. Case No. 294 of 2021.
