2 15-04-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State through video conferencing.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 414 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a) of the Excise Act, 2016.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 09.02.2022, he is a person with clean antecedent and charge-sheet has been submitted in this case.

Allegation is of recovery of 31.970 litre of liquor from a wooden box being carried on the motorcycle.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. He had parked his motorcycle and had gone to a shop when it



appears that someone had kept the said wooden box on the motorcycle.

Learned A.P.P. opposes the bail application.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody, he is a person with clean antecedent and charge-sheet has been submitted in this case, the petitioner, above-named, is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail-bonds in the sum of Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Fulwariya P. S. Case No.40 of 2022.

The application stands allowed.
