ORAL ORDER

2. In view thereof, the writ petition is dismissed in terms of the judgment dated 23.02.2022 passed in **C.W.J.C. No. 5489 of 2020 (Suresh Ram Vrs. The State of Bihar & Ors.)** and connected matters reported in **2022(2) P.L.J.R. 80** and the judgment dated 07.03.2022 passed in **C.W.J.C. No. 34 of 2022**



(Minakshi @ Sushre Minakshi & Anr. Vrs. The State of Bihar & Ors.), with liberty to file an appeal before the District Appellate Authority.

3. If an appeal is preferred before the District Appellate Authority/State Appellate Authority the same shall be taken-up at the earliest and preferably decided within a period of six months.
