2 27-04-2022 The appellant was removed from the post of

Anganwari Sewika on the ground that she was not a resident of

the Poshak Kshetra, which is a mandatory requirement.

The learned counsel for the appellant submits that

having worked for one year in that area as Anganwari Sewika,

she has acquired a right to continue besides the dispute about



the place of residence.

Under the circumstances, we have proposed that the appellant may file a representation before the District Magistrate, Nawada who shall once again verify as to which area the appellant belongs and pass appropriate orders. The Ld. Counsel for the appellant has no objection to the said proposal. It is ordered accordingly.

The present appeal stands disposed of.
