That, the writ petitioner is invoking the extraordinary writ jurisdiction of this Hon’ble Court for issuance of appropriate writ/writs, order/orders, direction/directions commanding the respondent authorities, specially respondent No. 2, Principal Secretary, Department of Science and Technology, Govt. of Bihar, Patna to grant promotional benefit to the petitioner with effect from the date as recommended by the Bihar Public Service Commission *vide* letter No. 2389 dated 24.01.2013 recommending promotional benefit to the petitioner



on the post of Lecturer Selection Grade/ Assistant Professor and accordingly, to grant consequential financial benefit thereof.
