2 26-05-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence under Sections 272, 273 of the I.P.C. and Section 30(a)
of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

81 liters of foreign liquor has been recovered from a
4-wheeler (Turbo), of which, this petitioner was occupant.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that nothing has
been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner.
Petitioner is neither owner nor driver of the said vehicle.
Petitioner claims clean antecedent and he is in custody since
09.09.2021. Investigation is complete.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail
petition.



Considering the nature of allegation, clean antecedent and period of custody, the bail petition of petitioner is allowed. Let the above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge II cum Special Judge Excise Act, Madhubani in connection with Bhairabsthan P.S. Case No. 105 of 2021, G.R. No. 1611 of 2021.
