Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

“1. That this writ application is being filed
for quashing the order dt. 20.05.2014 issued under
signature of respondent no. 4 by which rejected the
application of the petitioner which was filed for



compliance of the order dt 03.04.2014 passed in CWJC No. 1912/2014 by which hold that the case was pending against the petitioner hence, his case has not been considered for appointment on the post of Secretary Jalchhajan Samiti, in view of the Circular contains Annexure-1 by which clearly shown that the applicant's application shall not be considered when he was convicted in any criminal cases. In view of the letter dt. 20.05.2014 is illegal and further issue direction to respondent to consider the case of the petitioner for appointment, in view of the Government Circular dt. 17.09.2013 and further give other legal consequential benefit attached to the post.”

On 22.11.2022, we had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the respondents submits that petitioner’s claim for inclusion in the list of Secretary, stood rejected on account of a criminal case bearing no. 98 of 2013, registered on 27.09.2013.

Despite repeated calls, none has entered appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

However, in the interest of justice, matter is adjourned.
