2 12-08-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30 (a) and
30(2) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

It is a case of recovery of foreign liquor from a truck.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He
further submits that no incriminating article has been recovered
from the conscious or constructive possession of the petitioner
and he has no concern with the seized liquor or seized vehicle
and he has not been apprehended at the spot. Petitioner has
clean antecedent.



Learned APP appearing for the State opposed the anticipatory bail.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge Excise Act, Court No.II, Muzaffarpur in connection with Excise Case No. 349 of 2021, P.R. No.07 dated 18.08.2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
