learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Baniyapur P.S. Case No. 383 of 2019 registered under
Sections 498A/376/511/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner is unmarried *Nanad* of the informant. She
is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case.
There is no specific allegation against the petitioner. Further he
submits that petitioner has no concern with the alleged
occurrence.
