Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Chakia P.S. Case No. 90 of 2019 registered for the offences
under Sections 25(1-b)a, 26, 35 of the Arms Act.

Allegedly, from the possession of this petitioner an
automatic pistol with five live bullets was recovered.

The main submissions advanced by learned counsel
for the petitioner are that the petitioner has been languishing in
jail since 30th March, 2019, the alleged recovery of the firearms
was not made from the conscious possession of this petitioner



and he has been made accused in this case merely on the basis of his past criminal record.

Learned APP for the State has opposed the bail prayer.

Heard both the sides and perused the FIR and seizure list attached to the FIR. As per FIR the petitioner at the time of his arrest was carrying a reward of Rs. 50,000 on his arrest declared by State Government. And against him altogether nineteen criminal cases have been shown as his criminal antecedent and from his person an automatic pistol is stated to have been recovered along with five live bullets. Considering the nature of allegation appearing against the petitioner as well as his criminal antecedent of nineteen cases mentioned in the paragraph No. 3 of his petition, in my view petitioner does not deserve for bail. Accordingly his bail prayer stands rejected.
