2 19-09-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 379 and 411 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections Bihar Minerals Concession Prevention Illegal Mining Transportation and Storage Rules, 2019 and 56(1) of the Environment Protection Act, 1986 and 15 Act.

It is a case of theft of the sand causing loss of Rs.25,125/- to the State exchequer.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that petitioner is ready to pay Rs.10,000/- before the concerned Mining Department. Petitioner has clean



antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the State opposed the anticipatory bail.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, Jhanjharpur, District- Madhubani in connection with Laukaha (Lalmaniya) P.S. Case No. 296 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C with condition that at the time of furnishing bail bond, the petitioner shall produce the receipt of fine of Rs.10,000/-.
