“For issuance of writ/writs,
order/orders, direction/directions for
quashing the possession notice dated
26.02.2021 issued under the signature of
Authorized officer, State Bank of India,
SARB, Patna, Respondent No. 3 taking
possession of mortgaged immovable
property of Deed No. 4508, dated

28.11.2016, Mauza Mahammadpur, Thana No. 33, Anchal Manjhi, Registry office, Ekma, Distict Chapra, Khata No. 1197, Plot No. 3721, Tauzi 683, 685, area 7.4 Decimal (2 katha) and vide Deed No. 4596 dated 5.12.2016 and correction deed no. 4643 dated 09.12.2016 Mauza Mahammadur, Thana No. 33, Anchal Manjhi, Registry Office Ekma, District Chapra, Khata No. 1197, Khesra No. 3721, Tauzi 683, 685, Area 29.76 Decimal (8 katha) and further for a direction to the respondents to settle the dues amount under the policy of the Central Government regarding the sick unit and also under the Scheme for One Time Settlement of NPAs & AUCAs (SBI OTS 2020) and further direct the respondents to give appropriate assistance to the unit of the petitioner so that the petitioner may repay the amount to the respondents and further for any other relief/reliefs as the petitioner is found entitled to in the facts and circumstances of the case for the ends of Justice.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.
