“That this writ application is being filed for
issuance of writ nature of certiorari for quashing the
memo no.340 dt 03.06.2013 issued under signature
of the respondent no. 2 by which order that Block
Education Officer shall be worked as Block
Resource Centre Co- ordinater (B.R.CC.) in place of



the petitioner with temporary effect without asking any show cause or giving any opportunity to the petitioner and further issue direction to the respondents grant the benefit to the petitioner at appointed as B.R.C.C. as discharging duty since 29.04. 2013 to till today but benefit of B.R.C.C has given as per the guideline issued by the respondent for appointment as B.R.C.C. and further give other legal consequential benefit attached to the post.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to take recourse to such remedy as available in law.
