APP for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to
remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a
period of four weeks from today.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Maniyari P.S. Case No. 273 of 2020 for offences under
Section 414 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is the owner of Pick-Up van, which is a
commercial vehicle and he is not expected to be present in the
vehicle whenever it is taken for hire.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the
prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is allowed.

Accordingly, let petitioner, above-named, in the event



of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Muzaffarpur in connection with Maniyari P.S. Case No. 273 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
