2 22-04-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State through video conferencing.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Section 30(a) of the Excise Act,
2018.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is in custody since 22.01.2022, he is a person with
clean antecedent and charge-sheet has been submitted in this
case.

Allegation is of recovery of 10019.7 litre of liquor
from the container.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is the driver of the container and as such, no was
knowing what was loaded in the container by the owner and



transporter.

Learned A.P.P. opposes the bail application.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody, he is a person with clean antecedent and charge-sheet has been submitted in this case, the petitioner, above-named, is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail-bonds in the sum of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Bhaptiyahi P. S. Case No.10 of 2022.

The application stands allowed.
