2 28-09-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 149, 341, 323 and 308/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly, it is a case of assault due to which the informant sustained injuries.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that vide Annexure-2 shows that lacerated wound on frontal region which sustained by hard and blunt substance and the injuries are simple in nature.

Learned APP appearing for the State opposed the anticipatory bail.



Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Arwal in connection with Kurtha P.S. Case No. 140 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
