Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Saharghat P.S. Case No. 113 of 2020 (G.R. No. 964 of 2020) for the offence punishable under Sections 307, 342, 354-B, 457, 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw this bail application on behalf of petitioner no.1, who has been arrested.

Accordingly, this bail application is dismissed as withdrawn as against petitioner no.1, above named.



Considering the fact that there is general and omnibus allegations against the petitioner and he has no criminal antecedent, this bail application on behalf of petitioner no.2 is allowed.

Let the petitioner no.2, above named, in the event of his arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M.-II, Benipatti (Madhubani) in connection with Saharghat P.S. Case No. 113 of 2020 (G.R. No. 964 of 2020), subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
