**ORAL ORDER**

3      29-01-2022                      Heard learned senior counsel for the petitioner and the  
learned A.P.P. for the State through video conferencing.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Sigori P.S.  
Case No. 94 of 2019 registered for the offence under Sections  
341, 323, 324, 307, 504, 34 and Section 302 of the Indian Penal  
Code.

According to the prosecution, the husband of the  
informant has been killed by the petitioner and his associates  
inflicting knife blow.

Learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner  
submits that the petitioner, who is of clean antecedent, is  
innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. He further  
submits that it is apparent from the F.I.R, itself that the allegation  
against the petitioner is to the extent only that he caught hold the



deceased with the help of co-accused Chautala Singh but no specific allegation of assault or any overt act is attributed to the petitioner. The specific allegation of assault by knife is attributed to Rakesh Singh @ Chunnu Singh, who is said to be son of the petitioner. The police after investigation has submitted charge sheet in this case exonerating the co-accused, Chautala Singh and others from the charges. He further submits that pursuant to the order of Hon'ble Apex Court dated 13.10.2020 passed in S.L.A. (Crl.) 4410 of 2020, petitioner has surrendered and he has been languishing judicial custody since 28.11.2020.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has submitted that there is allegation against the petitioner that he with the help of co-accused has caught hold the deceased and the co-accused, Rakesh Singh @ Chunnu Singh gave knife blow upon the husband of the informant.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the, above named, petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M.-V, Danapur in connection with Sigori P.S. Case No. 94 of 2019 with the following conditions:-

(1) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the Court and shall remain physically present as directed by the Court and



on his/her absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, his/her bail bond shall be canceled by the Court below.

(2) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses, in that case, the prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.

And, further condition that the court below shall verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner and in case at any stage, it is found that the petitioner has concealed his criminal antecedent, the court below shall take step for cancellation of bail bond of the petitioner. However, the acceptance of bail bonds in terms of the above-mentioned order shall not be delayed for purpose of or in the name of verification.
