2 20-09-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 307, 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is a case of assault due to which, the husband of the informant sustained injury.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that the injuries are simple in nature as opined by the doctor as evident from Annexure-2 series. Petitioner has clean antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the State opposed the



anticipatory bail.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM, Barh, Patna in connection with Bakhtiyarpur P.S. Case No. 216 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
