2 18-05-2022 Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

1. That this is an application for issuance of appropriate writ or writs, order or direction to the Respondents for quashing the order as contained in letter dated 26-11-2019 [Annexure-8] and letter dated 15-07-2021 [Annexure-10] by which Petitioner's candidature for award of Retail Outlet Dealership at location - Within 3 KM. from Hanuman Mandir Saraiya towards Sonbarsha Ghat on NH 107 (RHS) District- Khagaria, has been held as ineligible. The writ application is also for a direction to the Respondents to consider the candidature of Petitioner valid for award of Retail Outlet Dealership at the aforesaid location and to issue LOI in favour of the Petitioner as per Draw of Lots held on 21-06-2019 and the declaration of Result dated 21-06-2019 in favour of the Petitioner.



After the matter was heard for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to file a fresh petition, with better particulars, on the same and subsequent cause of action, if so required and desired.

Permission granted with liberty as prayed for.

Liberty also reserved to the petitioner to make a mention for listing of the petition on priority basis. As and when any such mention is made, Registry shall take steps for listing the petition at the earliest.

Instant petition stands disposed of as withdrawn in the aforesaid terms.
