“That by this writ application, the petitioners seeks indulgence of this Hon'ble Court for issuance of an appropriate writ or direction commanding the respondents to consider and make payment of difference of arrear of salary with effect from 01.06.2002 to 30.11.2006 in the light of the stay order of this Hon'ble High Court as well as the decisions of the Hon'ble Appex



Court and further treat the Regular service of the work charge Establishment period in continuation, prior to the date of absorption in permanent establishment in view of the resolution no.229 dated 07.04.2011 and maintained the status of pay scale of the petitioners, as the respondent has granted the said benefits of similarly situated and Junior Persons, when the petitioners are discharging the duties of the said post contineously with satisfactory service, since the date of initial appointment i.e. last 32 years and further the petitioners challenges the arbitrary and high handed action of the respondents in passing the order of Absorption in the permanent establishment is wholly contrary to the settled decision of the Hon'ble Court and circular of the State Govt.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.
