That this is an application for issuance of writ/ writs, order / orders and direction / directions in the nature of mandamus by commanding/ directing the Respondent authority to make payment of Rs. 12,36,048/- final bill of renovation of Jhajha Ahar / Pyne, contract work approved by the Respondent No.5 and earnest amount of Rs. 5,00,000/- with its interest @12% per annum from the period on which the tender work finalization certificate has already been issued within stipulated period of time, after completion of the work i.e. since 09.08.2018 up to its realization with its litigation cost.
