because of COVID-19 pandemic restrictions.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is expected to
honour his undertaking to remove the defects as pointed out by
the office when called upon to do so by the office.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been
filed by the petitioner apprehending his arrest in connection
with Bhabua P.S. Case no. 595 of 2019 instituted for the offence
under Sections 147, 148, 149, 342, 323, 307 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Prosecution story relates to abuse and assault to the
informant by the petitioner and other co-accused persons over a
trivial dispute relating to motorcycle collide.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner



has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. There is case and counter case between the parties. General and omnibus allegations have been levelled against the petitioner. Both parties have received injuries in alleged occurrence. Injury received by the informant is simple in nature. He has got no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of Bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender in connection with Bhabua P.S. Case no. 595 of 2019, he will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kaimur (Bhabua) subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
