ORAL ORDER**

4 18-01-2022 Heard the parties through video conferencing.

Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner and learned APP appearing on behalf of the State.

Let the defect(s) be removed within two weeks of the
complete start of the physical Court in normal course.

Petitioner who is in custody since 20.10.2020 seeks
regular bail in connection with Dhanha P.S. Case No. 249 of
2020 registered for offences punishable under Sections 363 and
364(A) of the Indian Penal Code.

Prosecution case in brief is that the grandson of the
informant, aged about 7 years, has been found missing since
14.10.2020.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case



due to ulterior motive. The F.I.R. has been lodged against unknown persons and the alleged child has been recovered. He further submits that petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 20.10.2020.

Learned A.P.P., has opposed the prayer for bail to the petitioner. He further submits that from the perusal of the paragraph no. 49 of the case diary it appears that the victim child has been recovered.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the Court below is directed to seek report from the Superintendent of Police, West Champaran, regarding the criminal antecedent of the petitioner, if the petitioner is not involved in any case prior to the present case, the petitioner above named is directed to be enlarged on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bagaha, West Champaran in connection with Dhanha P.S. Case No. 249 of 2020 Subject to the following conditions:

(i) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the Court concerned.



(ii) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the Court.

(iii) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
