Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Kharagpur P.S. Case No. 435 of 2019 registered for
offences under Sections 341, 323, 447, 504/34 of the Indian

withdrawal of the application for allowing the petitioner to
surrender and pray for regular bail in the Court below as all the
