The grievance of the petitioner is that confiscation proceeding was started against him long time back but no notice was issued. The vehicle is in the custody of the forest officials for the last two years.

Any delay in disposal thereof would attract punitive action. The respondent no. 1 shall initiate such action and send a report to this Court.
