2 01-09-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Chiraiya P.S.
Case No. 122 of 2020, registered for the offences punishable
under Sections 307, 379 of the Indian Penal Code and section 27
of the Arms Act.

As per the prosecution case, thirteen FIR named
accused persons including petitioner assaulted the informant and
his son. Petitioner is alleged to have assaulted the son of
informant. The doctor has found the injury to be simple in
nature.

It is submitted that There is case and counter case.
Both sides sustained injuries. Case filed the petitioner's side is
in earlier point of time. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.



Considering the facts aforesaid, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, East Champaran, Motihari in connection with Chiraiya P.S. Case No. 122 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
