2 19-12-2022 Though the present writ petition has been filed seeking to challenge the order dated 28.03.2022, passed by the Additional Inspector General, Registration, Saran Division, Chapra in Stamp Case no. 12 of 2022, however the learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to file appropriate appeal, challenging the said order dated 28.03.2022. Liberty so sought, is granted.

It is needless to state that in case, appropriate appeal is filed within a period of four weeks from today, the same shall



be considered on merits without the Appellate Authority being impeded by the issue of limitation and a reasoned and a speaking order shall be passed, in accordance with law, within a period of twelve weeks, thereafter.
