2 29-04-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Kharik P.S. Case No. 41 of 2021 for the offence punishable under Section 30(A)/38(i) of the Excise Act.

It has been submitted that the petitioner is a handicapped person and the recovery of illicit liquor is from the orchard but the Police has recorded that the liquor was recovered from the house. It has also been submitted that the mother of the petitioner has been arrested and the petitioner has clean antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, this bail application is allowed.



Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 2nd A.D.G. -cum- Special Judge, Excise Act, Bhagalpur, in connection with Kharik P.S. Case No. 41 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
