“(i) For issuance of a Writ in the nature of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ/order/direction to the respondent Bihar Public Service Commission, to recommend the name of petitioner forth with for appointment on the post of Sub-Inspector, Police in the light of the direction made earlier by this Hon’ble Court vide order dated 07.10.1999, passed in C.W.J.C. No. 6591/1992.

(ii) For a direction to the State respondent-specially the Home Commissioner to appoint the petitioner against a vacant post of Sub-Inspector of Police, after such recommendation being made by the B.P.S.C.



(iii) Any other relief/reliefs to which
the petitioner is found entitled.”

may be permitted to withdraw the present petition.
