The petitioners seek anticipatory bail in connection with Bihta P.S. Case No. 836 of 2020, registered for the offence under Sections 341, 323, 354, 379, 504, 506, 307, and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering the nature of dispute and nature of injury, this application for anticipatory bail is allowed.

Let the petitioners, in the event of their arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the court below, be released on



bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Danapur, Patna in connection with Bihta.S.
