If any such application is filed before the Superintendent of Police, Rohtas at Dehri (respondent no. 3) within a period of 30 days from today, the same will be looked into, examined and an appropriate order thereon shall be passed by respondent no. 3.



The respondent no. 3 shall fix a date for hearing the petitioners and will give them an appropriate hearing as well.

Let the entire exercise be completed within 60 days from the date of filing of the application before respondent no. 3.

The application stands disposed of accordingly.
