ORAL ORDER

2 01-11-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

Let the defect(s), if any, be removed within a period
of four weeks.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 467,
468, 471 and 120B of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is a person with clean antecedent.

The informant alleges that petitioner secured
appointment as teacher based on forged matriculation
certificate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the
present case. It is further submitted that had an opportunity been



given to the petitioner to explain his side of the case perhaps he would have been in a position to explain but without giving any opportunity to the petitioner to explain his side of the case the present FIR came to be instituted. It is next submitted that during the course of investigation vigilance did not investigate the folder and the petitioner had not submitted the mark sheet.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Jamui P.S. Case No. 541 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
