ORAL ORDER

2 05-12-2022 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1.(i) For issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus commanding the respondents to appoint the petitioner on the post of constable.”

The learned counsel for the respondent-State has referred to paragraph no. 11 of the counter affidavit, filed in the present case, which reads as follows:-

“11. That the facts related with the process of appointment requires no comments as it is a matter of record, office record speaks that petitioner having Roll No. 54315 applied for Bhagalpur district in general category and obtained 13 Marks, where as the last



*recruitment done in this quota obtained 15
Marks and as such was not rightly appointed.”*

In view of the aforesaid, this Court finds that the petitioner could not obtain the minimum cut-off marks, hence was not appointed, thus, this Court does not find any merit in the present writ petition, hence the same stands dismissed.
