2. By filing the present writ application the petitioner
seeks following reliefs:

*“i) For issuance of direction upon
respondent authorities to pay arrear of salary of
the petitioner for the period 17.11.2009 to
19.11.2011 which remained due with them.*

*ii) For further to hold that the petitioner
is entitled to get due arrear of salary for the period*



during which he has actually worked.

iii) For any other relief or reliefs for which the petitioner is found entitled in the facts and circumstances of the case.”
